## Background Overview

Andipa have been established as the go-to gallery for Banksy original paintings and works for almost 20 years. In addition to their leading collection of Banksy, the gallery also champion works across major artists including Warhol, Lichtenstein, Picasso and Matisse. Established at the same townhouse since 1967 and first recognised in Venice in 1593. Andipa are Collectors, Curators and Advisors with over £100M of artworks available to collectors. Andipa curates the unauthorised exhibition, *Banksy: Building Castles in the Sky*, currently touring through Europe and USA.
