KM 8000 hobs and M Sense cookware (dishwasher safe) are designed to take the stress out of cooking. Each piece of M Sense cookware features three integrated temperature sensors, which continuously monitor the heat inside the cookware and communicate directly with the hob. The hob then automatically adjusts power to maintain the ideal temperature throughout the cooking process, helping to prevent boiling over or food catching on the base. Rather than relying on manual power changes alone, the system actively supports the cooking process, delivering consistent results whether gently melting chocolate, simmering sauces or searing meat.

Maximum Flexibility

Priced from £1,299 - £4,299 the new KM 8000 60cm, 80cm and 90cm induction hobs combine intelligent power management with generous cooking space and precision-engineered glass ceramic finishes developed for long-term durability. Full-surface induction models allow cookware to be placed almost anywhere across the cooking area, with intelligent pan detection automatically recognising position and size. Up to six pots or pans can be used simultaneously, with power levels adjusting seamlessly as cookware is moved across the surface.

Models with large PowerFlex zones can be used individually or combined, making them ideal for larger cookware such as fish kettles or griddles, while ensuring power follows the cookware for uninterrupted cooking performance.

Most models in the new KM 8000 hob series feature MultiSlide controls, where each pot or pan has its own slider with clear displays for power levels and timers. In Professional Mode, the full-surface induction hob can be divided into three power zones, from high heat for searing at the front to low heat for warming at the rear, with power adjusting automatically as cookware is moved. This unique feature offers full control for home cooks and professional chefs alike.

The Miele app offers new features, including Food Assistant to help find the perfect recipe for various ingredients then sending it directly to the cookware, and CookAssist to guide users through step-by-step recipes tailored to M Sense cookware with temperatures and cooking times automatically transferred, too.

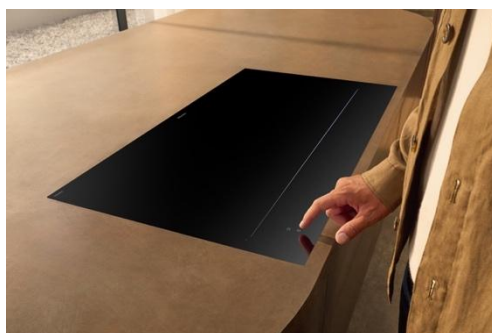
