London Embroidery Studio to Exhibit New Bespoke Work at House of Icon During Shoreditch Design Week

The Haggerston-based studio, known for innovative machine embroidery for luxury fashion, film and interiors, presents a new body of work for interior designers, design agencies and creative directors, 15–17 September.

The London Embroidery Studio (TLES) will exhibit new bespoke work at House of Icon from 15–17 September, as part of Shoreditch Design Week. The presentation introduces recent pieces developed by the studio's in-house design team, exploring texture, dimension and material application with machine embroidery. The studio has spent 20 years refining machine embroidery techniques for use beyond the garment, in surface, panel and object-based work suited to interior and spatial design.

Founded in 2007 and based in Haggerston, East London, TLES is a bespoke embroidery studio led by a four-strong team of full-time designers. The studio's work spans luxury fashion, film and television costume, stage costume and set design, interior textiles, visual merchandising and CMF design, giving it a working fluency across disciplines that few embroidery studios of its scale can offer. Collaborators and clients include Dior, Louis Vuitton, Hermès, Celine, JW Anderson, Priestmangoode, Argent design, Callum Design for Aston Martin, and Blinkink.

For interior designers, design agencies and creative directors, the studio offers bespoke embroidered textiles and objects developed collaboratively from brief to finished piece — for use in hospitality, retail, residential and commercial interiors, as well as visual merchandising installations and material development for CMF programmes. The House of Icon presentation is an opportunity to see this work first-hand and to discuss commissions directly with the studio's design team.
