

Sound & Colour at Counter 71 and Lowcountry



To celebrate London Design Week this September, **Counter 71** and **Lowcountry** — the intimate chef's table and cocktail bar spread across two floors of a converted Shoreditch pub — will present *Sound & Colour*, a limited-edition sensory dining experience available for just **five special sittings**.

Priced at **£90 per person**, *Sound & Colour* will feature a **seven-course monochromatic tasting menu**, accompanied by a welcome drink crafted with **El Rayo Tequila** (or a non-alcoholic Kir Royale). Each dish will be inspired by a single colour and soundtracked by a curated playlist of songs inspired - in name or context - by that hue.

Each guest will also be invited to select a colour on arrival, which will then be transformed into a **bespoke cocktail** made with El Rayo. The space itself will feature **artworks on loan from El Rayo's artist collaborations**, such as Alejandra Garcia y Gutierrez, Daniel Barreto, and Hola Lou to complete the connection between flavour, sound, and design.

Created by chef Joe Laker and bartender Ryan Sheehan — who first met at Fenn in Fulham — the concept unites its founders' heritage under one roof - bringing together a restaurant with an unwavering commitment to British-sourced ingredients, ranging from the traditional to the unconventional, and an underground cocktail bar that celebrates American ryes, bourbons and whiskeys. Though distinct in design and theme, both spaces reflect Laker and Sheehan's respective influences, and their shared passion for exceptional hospitality without pretence.
