Hornscape Playground: A Celebration of Sound, Motion, and Play



Taiwanese artist **Wang, Chung-Kun** will present his latest work, *Hornscape Playground*, at the **2025 London Design Festival** (13–21 September). This interactive installation blends sound, movement, and spatial design to create a multisensory experience that sparks curiosity and delight—entirely powered without electricity.



The playground is composed of tubular forms shaped into a minimalist elephant-like silhouette. It features horn-shaped sound pipes and swingable seats. When users swing,

internal pneumatic mechanisms are activated, producing horn-like sounds in varying frequencies. At the same time, the seats themselves emit playful noises through interaction, making each sound entirely generated by the users.





Hornscape Playground emphasizes **interactivity and social inclusivity**, inviting both children and adults to engage in a joyful journey where movement and sound intertwine. The installation will be exhibited outdoors during the London Design Festival, welcoming visitors from around the world to participate in this unique sonic celebration.
