About the Wax Building

WAX 2025 -Exhibition Dates: 13–21 September

The Wax Building is London's latest epicentre for independent British design. Home to **Cozmo**, **Tamart, Minimalux** and **LightMass^**, this permanent creative hub occupies a former Victorian furniture waxing and shellacking factory at 4 Garden Walk, Shoreditch. Spread across four floors, the building has been reimagined as a year-round space for innovation, collaboration and designled experiences.

Since launching at the London Design Festival in September 2024, the Wax Building has established itself as a must-visit destination on the Shoreditch Design Triangle map. Now in its second year, **Wax 2025** brings together the founding brands with an expanded line-up of leading voices in contemporary design, including Pearson Lloyd, Studiomama, Point Two Five and Liberty.

This year's programme highlights the interplay and fluid connections between the four brands:

- Cozmo takes over two floors of The WAX Building presenting the Cozmo collection by Raw Edges in their ground floor showroom and 'Comfort Lab' by Pearson Lloyd in the Cozmo Studio on the second floor, unveiling the new Hug Sofa.
- **Tamart** transforms the first floor into *TT Lounge Bar*—inspired by 1960's design and complete with new Highgate Bar Stools and Liberty-upholstered Clore easy chairs.
- **Minimalux** marks its 15-year journey with *ORIGIN*, an exhibition defining the essence of the brand to the present day releasing the new lighting design NIL.
- **LightMass^** by Raw Edges immerses visitors in a sculptural installation of new integrated LED lighting in the lower ground floor gallery.
- Guest jewellery brand **Point Two Five (0.25)** activates the WAX stairwell with *Step by Step*, a site-specific installation featuring new pieces by Studiomama.

Alongside the residents, the Wax Building welcomes a stellar guest roster: **Pearson Lloyd, Point Two Five, Liberty, Studiomama, music label Ascension of Wax, Brown Office, Sebastian Bergne, Layered, Daniel Eatock, Theodora Alfredsdottir, Wendy Andreu, Jamie Wolfond, 108.Pictures, Crate Brewery and many more.**
