Tamart is the British furniture brand celebrating the powerful love story of two polymaths, Tamar De Shalit and Arthur Goldreich, brought to life by their son Amos Goldreich, Tamart's founder.

Presenting the **Tamart Lounge Bar** at this year's Festival, the Tamart showroom is transformed. The **Tamart Lounge Bar** is a social space where hospitality and home come to life. With three distinct zones, each hub represents a different facet of lounging – from hotel and bar to penthouse living. Inspired by the lounge bars and clubs of yesteryear – these were destinations for comfort and relaxation, for conversation and connection, of pleasure and leisure.

At the centre of the newly configured space is the cocktail bar, originally designed by Tamar de Shalit in 1964–66 for a private members club, reimagined for the Festival. Tamart patrons are invited to perch on the new **Highgate High Barstools** which are making their debut in September. The bar places guests right at the heart of the action. The Highgate barstools aren't just seating – they're a front-row invitation to the full cocktail experience.

Adjacent to the bar is the cinema area, complete with the screening of Tamart's multi-award winning film Powered By Love, directed and produced by the hugely talented 108. Pictures. Here, Red Rock Club Chairs upholstered in Tamart's own striking black & white Contrast pure wool fabric give the audience a low, comfortable seating solution to sit and watch some silver screen moments.

The interior area of the club has Clore Lounge Chairs and Ottomans upholstered in Liberty coral Shadow Stripe graphic fabric alongside smoked glass-top coffee and dining tables with lighting accents from the Clore Floor Lamp. This is the perfect destination for a meeting or a game of cards. To complete the installation, a rug from Layered, designed by Swedish visionary artist Tekla Evelina Severin, better known as Teklan, adds the radically modern finishing touch.

Expect a fusion of colour, pattern and crafted furniture, where a carefully curated collection of Tamart designs come together, bringing a vibrant edge to their modernist furniture. Tamart welcomes everyone into their social **Tamart Lounge Bar** to discover the newly reimagined showroom and pick up the latest catalogue complete with products and projects.

Tamart is located on the first floor of The Wax Building – the new dynamic creative space that houses independent British design brands permanently, set over a four-storey Victorian warehouse. WAX 2025 is the second year at LDF and will host 20 invited special guests to exhibit and participate over the Festival. According to Amos Goldreich, 'As partners of both LDF and Shoreditch Design Triangle, it is a great opportunity for emerging brands like Tamart to be seen on the global design stage and integrated into the creative Shoreditch story.'

The new Highgate High Stool exemplifies Tamart's dedication to modernist principles and sustainable craftsmanship. Created by Amos Goldreich from his designer parents' legacy, it harmonises strict geometry with refined softness – featuring a pill-shaped angled backrest, gently curved stile tops and feet, and a naturally dyed leather sling seat.

The Highgate High Stool is an extension to the award-winning Highgate Seating Collection. Available in four versions and two heights for high bars or counters with or without backrests for multiple applications. The lightly padded leather seat, with contrast waxed stitching, is tension-fitted, allowing the comfort to be adjusted and refreshed.

Tamart's Tension Fitted Seating

Tension seating draws on both ergonomics and practicality. It is characterised by its suspended seat and back and has for centuries been used as the basis for many chair designs. However, Tamart's revolutionary tension seating allows users to adjust the seating by an easy-to-use system.

In order to limit the usual stretching of the leather, it has been backed with natural canvas and both sides are attached to the new tensioning system. This innovative system, fully integrated and concealed within the side rails of the chair, offers the simplest setup possible to enable customers to adjust the seat to the desired tension with an Allen key. The mechanism not only offers a reset of the seat's tension, but it also allows users to change the angle of the seat: slack at the back and tight at the front edge for a relaxed position, or tight at the back and slack at the front edge for a more upright posture. The Highgate High Stool is both a classic and clever solution for home or hospitality projects.

The Highgate collection includes refined dining chairs, with or without arms and exemplifies Tamart taking its design cues from essential modernist principles with its simple rectangular construction and strict geometric appearance inspired by designs from the 1960s. The contemporary pill-shaped, comfortably angled back and bullnose curved stile top and feet soften the appearance, while the fine, naturally dyed leather sling-style seat gives the stool a lightness and elegance.

About Tamart

Tamart is a furniture and design brand founded by the London-based architect Amos Goldreich, honouring the lives and work of his late parents, the modernist architects and polymaths, Tamar de Shalit (1932–2009) and Arthur Goldreich (1928–2011). The brand celebrates the creative and romantic relationship of de Shalit and Goldreich, both key figures in the modernist design scene in Europe, the Middle East and Africa during the 1960s and 1970s, by reimagining and contemporising mid-century pieces designed and specified by them during their careers. Designs are drawn from and inspired by the vast collection of over 10,000 original plans, photographs, documents, and prototypes discovered by Goldreich after his parents' passing. Tamart products are skilfully crafted in sustainable materials and fabricated in the UK and Europe.

Since Tamart's launch in Milan in April 2024, it has gone from strength to strength, establishing a showroom in Shoreditch and growing its furniture families with all their designs currently in production. Tamart has also launched a new light and a series of accessories, all designed from the original archive material. Amos Goldreich commissioned a film, Powered By Love, the recipient of two prestigious film awards, directed and produced by 108. Pictures premiered during this year's London Festival of Architecture.

Wax Building is London's latest epicentre and permanent home for independent British design brands – **Cozmo**, **Tamart**, **Minimalux** and **LightMass**^. Nestled in the heart of Shoreditch at 4 Garden Walk and set over four floors, this former Victorian factory for waxing and shellacking furniture has been transformed into a vibrant space for creativity and innovation all year round. Launched in September 2024, the Wax Building has become a must-visit destination on the Shoreditch Design Triangle map. For its second year at the London Design Festival, '**Wax 2025**' will showcase installations and new products from all four founding brands with an expanded line-up of guests from the design world.

Wax 2025's programme highlights the interplay and connections between the four residents. Along with the **Tamart Lounge Bar** on the first floor and the new Highgate Bar Stools, Cozmo presents vibrant product displays on the ground floor and 'Comfort Lab' by Pearson Lloyd introducing Hug on the second floor; Minimalux marks its 15-year journey with ORIGIN, an exhibition defining the essence of the brand to the present day releasing the new lighting design NIL; LightMass^ by Raw Edges, immerses visitors in a new sculptural installation of integrated LED lighting on the lower ground floor space; and guest jewellery brand Point Two Five(0.25), activates the WAX stairwell with Step by Step, a site-specific exhibition featuring new work by Studiomama.
