Full circle

LAYER has expanded the successful Hula family for Spanish brand Andreu World. Originally a collection of height-adjustable bar stools, Hula is now a comprehensive furniture collection comprising a side chair, table range and club chair. The new pieces share the same simple geometric forms and intuitive functionality of the original collection, and can be specified across a wide range of hospitality and commercial spaces. The Hula Club chair will debut at Salone del Mobile in Milan in April 2026, with the full Hula collection launching at NeoCon in Chicago in June 2026 and unveiling now at London Design Festival.

A shared design language

The original Hula Stool is a contemporary swivel stool comprising a series of rotating elements, with a geometric language that creates the impression of a single, unified form. Since its launch, it has won multiple awards and become one of Andreu World's best-selling pieces. The expanded Hula collection draws on the four core design ingredients that defined the original stool: a continuous transition between elements; a concentric column; a pure, circular geometry; and a pillowed surface that creates both visual and physical comfort.

Hula Chair

The Hula Chair is a soft, inviting side chair that echoes the visual language and comfort cues of the original stool. Available with or without armrests, it offers varying levels of comfort to suit different settings. The armrest version features a backrest that grows organically into the arm, maintaining the seamless, flowing geometry that characterises the Hula family.

Multiple base options – including a pedestal base, a wooden base, a four-legged base, and a five-star base with castors – allow the chair to be specified for both dining and work environments. A swivel mechanism is integrated across all central stem bases, inviting movement and offering a more flexible seating experience. The result is a chair equally at home in a dining setting, a conference room or a collaborative workspace.

Hula Club Chair

The Hula Club Chair represents the biggest departure from the collection's formal language, yet is the closest in functional spirit. Like the Hula Stool, it is built around the idea of rotation and movement, with recessed castors that allow the chair to spin and face different orientations, encouraging conversation and interaction.

Central to the design is a leather handle at the back, which extends into a graphic line running down the rear of the chair. This detail serves a dual purpose as both a striking visual signature and as a practical means of repositioning the chair. The leather strip also cleverly conceals the upholstery zip to remove and wash the textile or leather cover.

With its revolved, circular form, the Hula Club carries over the welcoming, approachable geometry of the wider family while offering a deeper, more enveloping seat. It is designed for lobbies, breakout zones and transitional spaces where flexible informal comfort needs are prioritised.
