Hosted in collaboration with Studio Toer and Moooi, the evening explores how light extends beyond its functional purpose to become an architectural material capable of shaping space, defining atmosphere and influencing the way we inhabit our environments. At eba, light has always been understood as an essential design element—one that brings depth, rhythm and emotion to interior architecture. This philosophy is reflected throughout the showroom, where a curated selection of Moooi lighting, including designs by Studio Toer, forms an integral part of the spatial experience.

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eba Marylebone is delighted to host Kitchen in the Spotlight, a CPD-RIBA accredited talk with brunch during the London Design Festival, exploring the growing importance of lighting in contemporary kitchen design.

As kitchens continue to evolve into open, multifunctional living spaces, lighting has become far more than a technical requirement. It is an essential architectural tool that defines atmosphere, enhances ergonomics, establishes spatial relationships and improves the everyday experience of the home. This CPD session examines how lighting should be considered from the earliest stages of a project, integrated into furniture and architecture rather than introduced as a final layer.

Through practical examples and completed residential projects, the presentation explores the principles behind successful lighting design, including layered illumination, indirect lighting, colour temperature, visual comfort and the integration of lighting systems within kitchen furniture. The session also demonstrates how carefully designed lighting solutions contribute to functionality, material expression, spatial continuity and the relationship between kitchen and living spaces.

The talk covers a wide range of integrated solutions—from under-wall-unit lighting and illuminated shelving to cabinet interiors and display systems—illustrating how each strategy responds to both technical requirements and the emotional qualities of residential interiors. Real case studies will show how these principles are successfully applied across a variety of kitchen projects.

The session contributes to continuing professional development by offering practical knowledge and design insights for architects and interior designers seeking to create more functional, comfortable and atmospheric residential spaces.
