Celebrating a decade of obsession with movement and kinetic sculpture, Motion Sickness reveals the process behind the practice of Isabel + Helen. The exhibition offers a glimpse into the studio as a space of play, investigation, and continual invention, where mechanisms emerge through experimentation and evolve through discovery and refinement. Isabel and Helen are a design duo working at the intersection of art and design. Their studio-based practice is founded on experimentation, exploring movement, materials and mechanisms through analogue, hands-on processes. Graphic and joyful, the resulting experiences are driven by human input; an in-real-life antidote to the transience of the digital world. Their work has been exhibited at leading art institutions including The V&A, The Vitra Museum, Tate Modern and the Saatchi Gallery, as well as cultural and design festivals such as Coachella, Salone de Mobile, Milan and Paris Fashion Week.
