

Weaving Linocut into Interiors: Fabia.H.Goff Brings Print, Pattern and Place to House of ICON

15–17 September 2026 | Shoreditch Town Hall | House of ICON, Shoreditch Design Week

LONDON, September 2026 — Print and textile designer Fabia.H.Goff will showcase her large-scale, limited-edition linocuts, silk scarves and textiles at House of ICON in Shoreditch Town Hall from 15–17 September, as part of Shoreditch Design Week. Her exhibition brings hand-carved printmaking into the world of interiors and design, highlighting how original artwork and pattern can be developed into bespoke textiles, upholstery, furnishings and products.

From the Kent coast to contemporary interiors

At the heart of the showcase is 'Folkestone to Dover', an A1 multi-block linocut created using hand-mixed inks in various one-off colours and layers, including a hazy palette of coastal blues. This piece will be shown alongside last year's 'Folkestone West Sunset' and a collection of linocut silk scarves, fabrics and home décor.

Inspired by British flora, fauna and the coastline, Goff's work combines traditional printmaking with bold colour, expressive pattern and a strong sense of place. Her large-scale prints capture the atmosphere, texture and changing light of the landscapes, florals and skies that continue to shape her practice.

"I'm interested in what happens when a hand-carved artwork comes out of the frame. Print can become part of an interior — translated into textiles, upholstery, furnishings or a bespoke product — weaving the original print with the interior as a whole"

The showcase introduces Goff's collaborative practice. She hopes in showcasing her own designs, to illustrate how well this will work with interior designers, architects, hospitality spaces and brands and work on even more large-scale projects. Having previously worked as a product designer in industry for eight years, Goff brings considerable experience across ceramics, textiles and lighting, and how pattern translates onto product and in manufacture - informing a unique approach to linoprint and its cohesion with material, pattern, colour and product.

About Fabia.H.Goff

Fabia Hebe Goff is a printmaker and designer working across hand-carved linocut, textiles and interior applications. Her practice is rooted in the British landscape, particularly the flora, fauna and coastline of Kent. Through expressive mark-making, hand-mixed inks and bold pattern, she creates artwork and textiles designed to bring a sense of place into contemporary spaces.
