

Digital Drawing Workshop with leading illustrator Emanuel Santos for London Design Festival.

[Hackney, London] — London Fields Design School (LFDS) will host a Digital Drawing Workshop on Monday 14th September, 16:30–18:15, as part of the London Design Festival, offering participants a hands-on session with leading UK illustrator Emanuel Santos at the school's studio in Hackney.

About the Workshop

Taking place at LFDS's Hackney studio, the mini workshop invites participants to develop their digital image-making skills using Photoshop and a drawing tablet, provided on the day. Led by Santos, the session will cover practical tips and techniques for creating polished digital artwork, whether as standalone illustrations or as assets for larger design projects.

Run in a small-group setting, the workshop is designed for those who already have a working knowledge of Photoshop, including experience with layer management, layer masks, and clipping masks, allowing the group to focus on refining more advanced digital drawing techniques.
